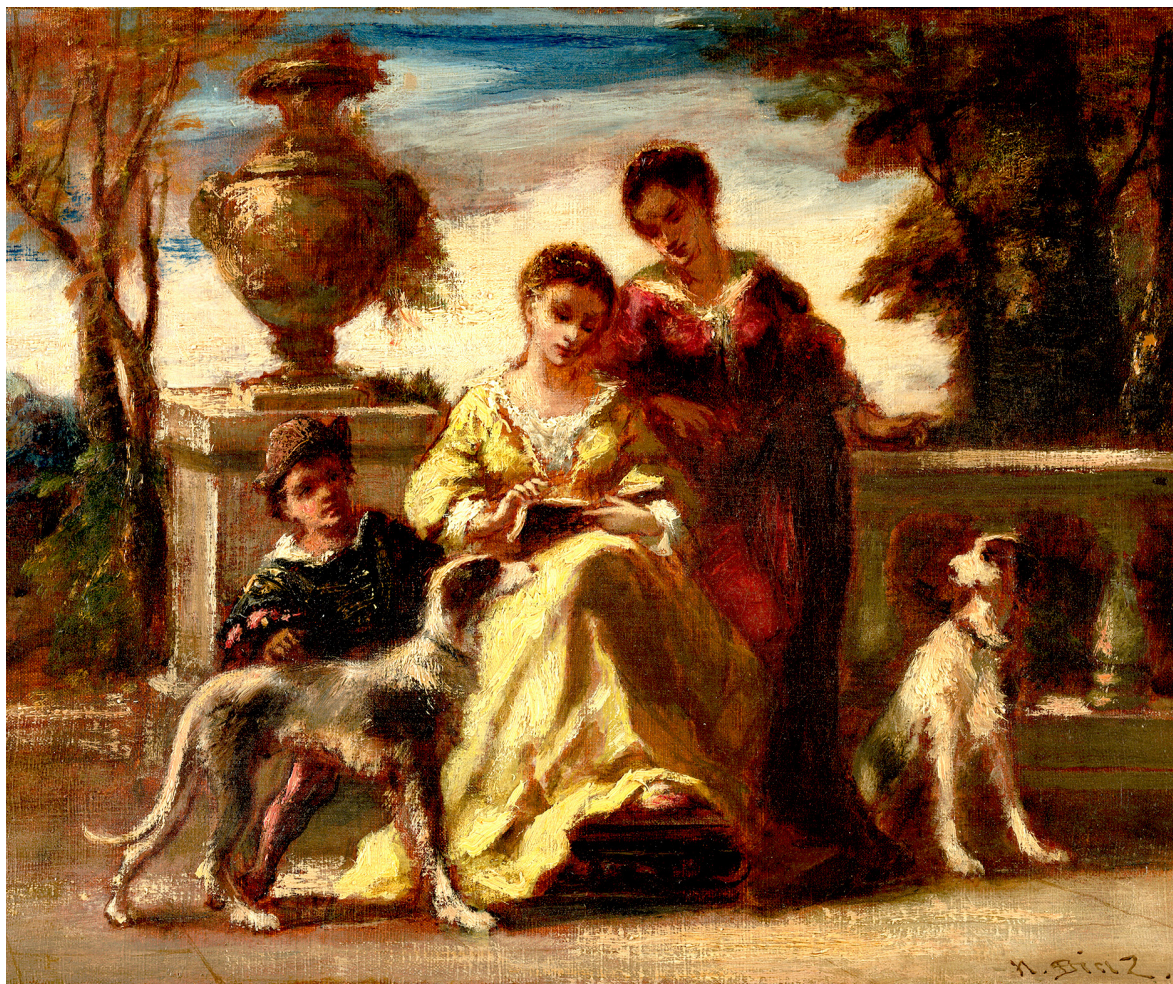

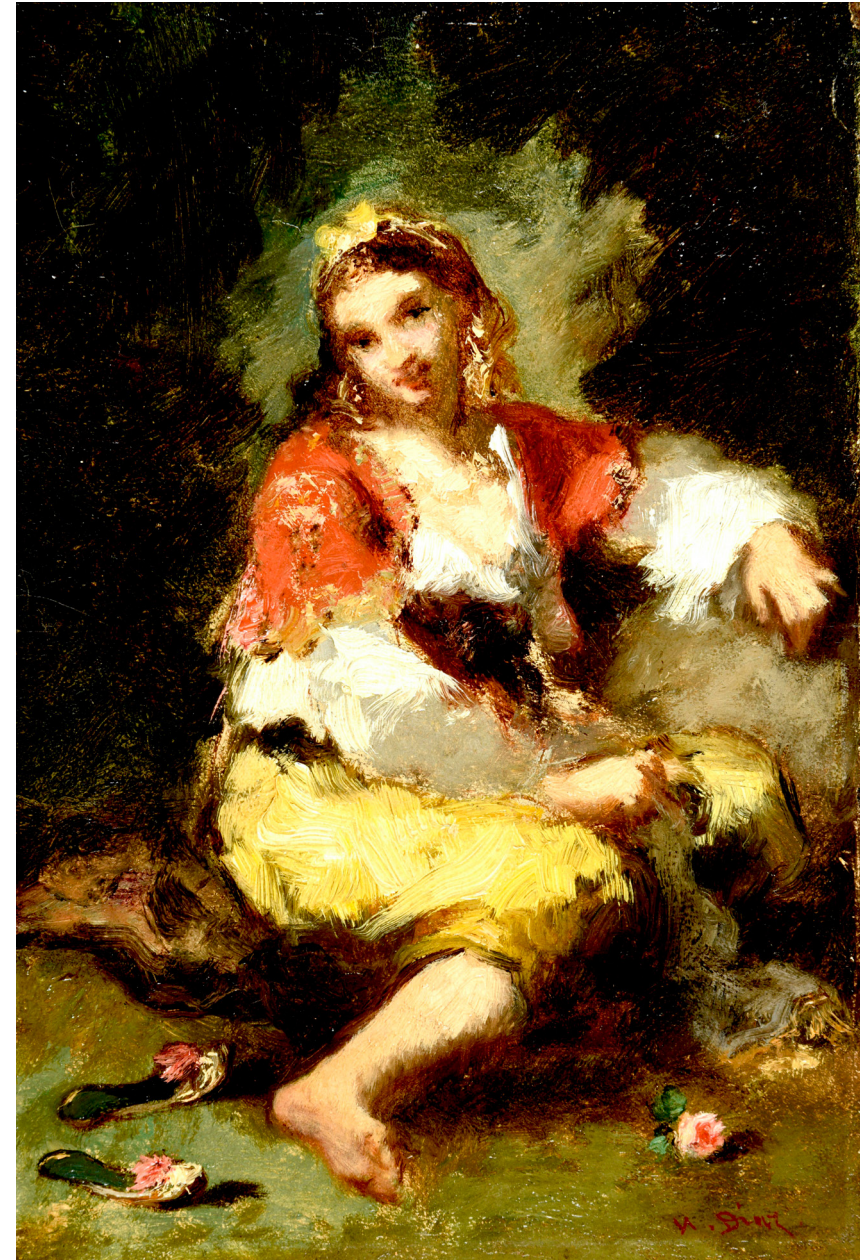

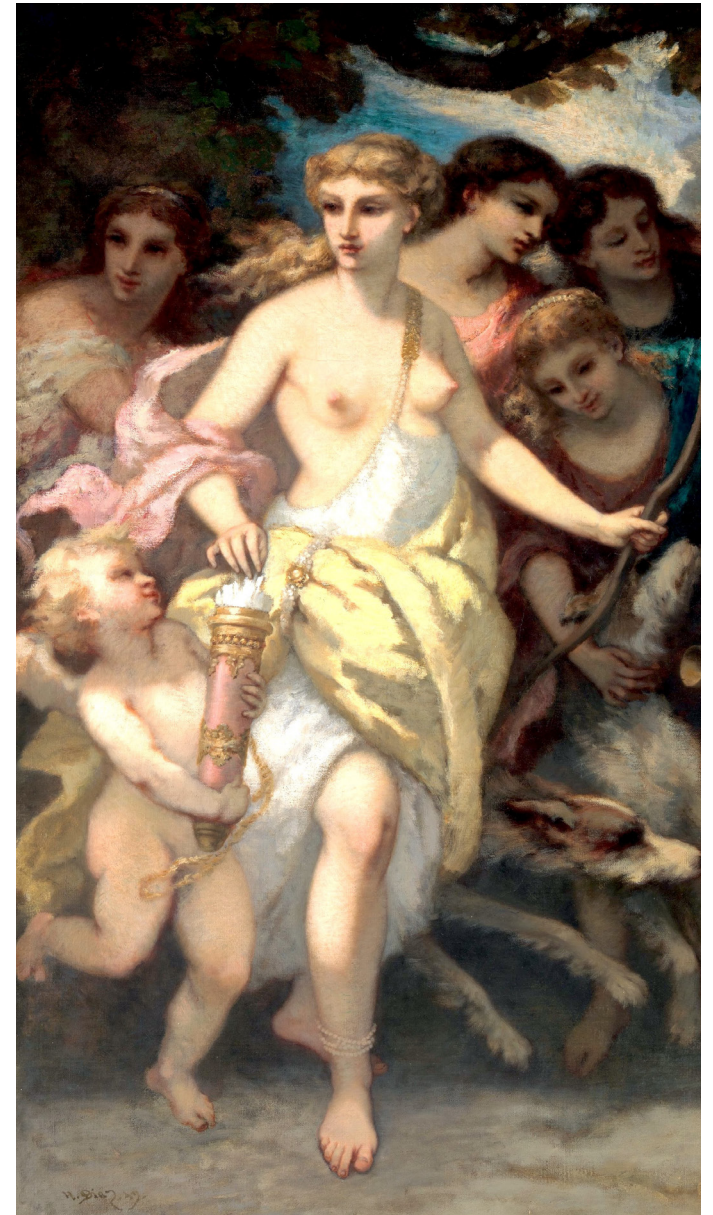

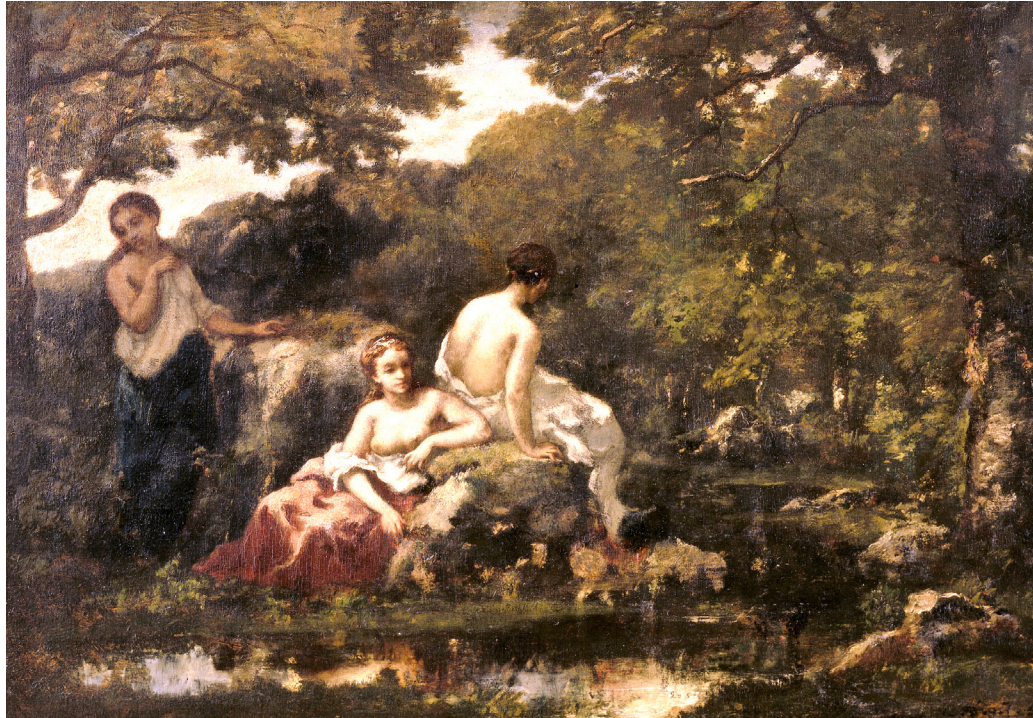

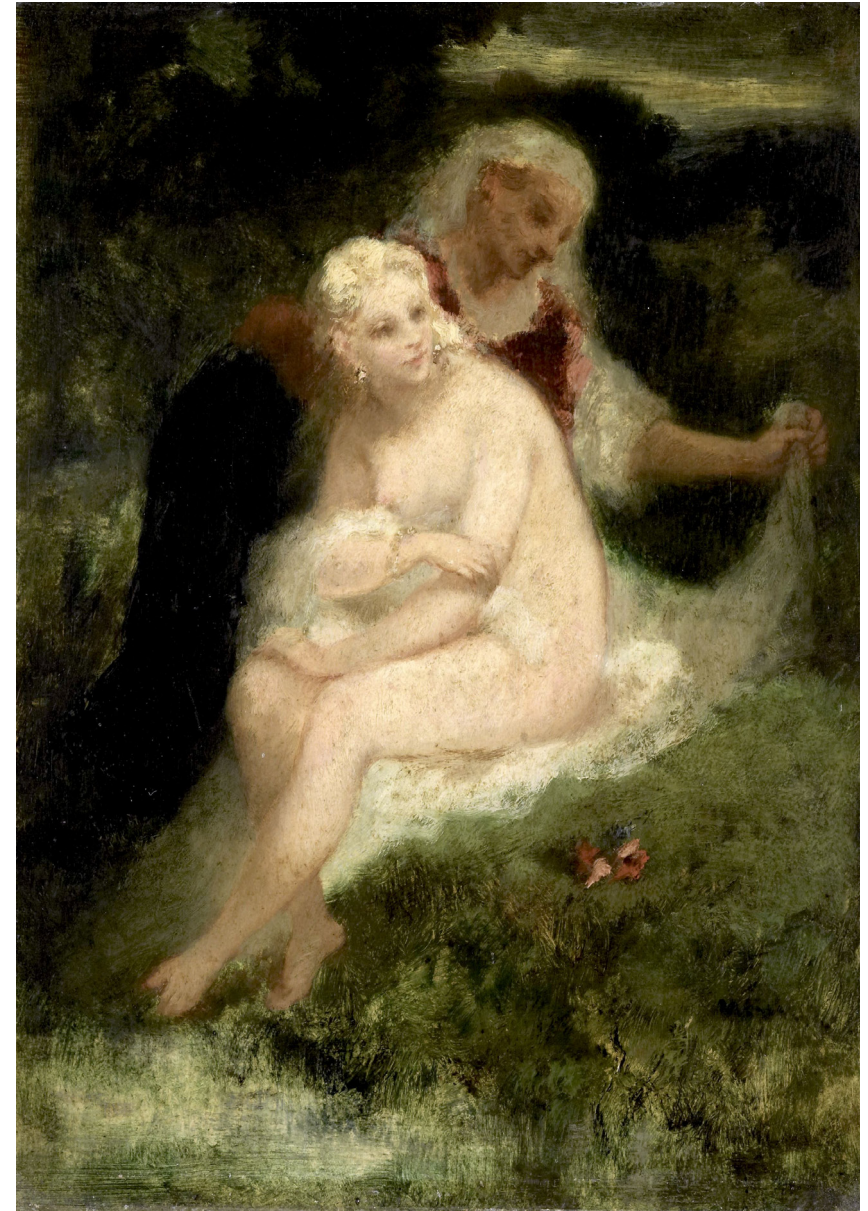

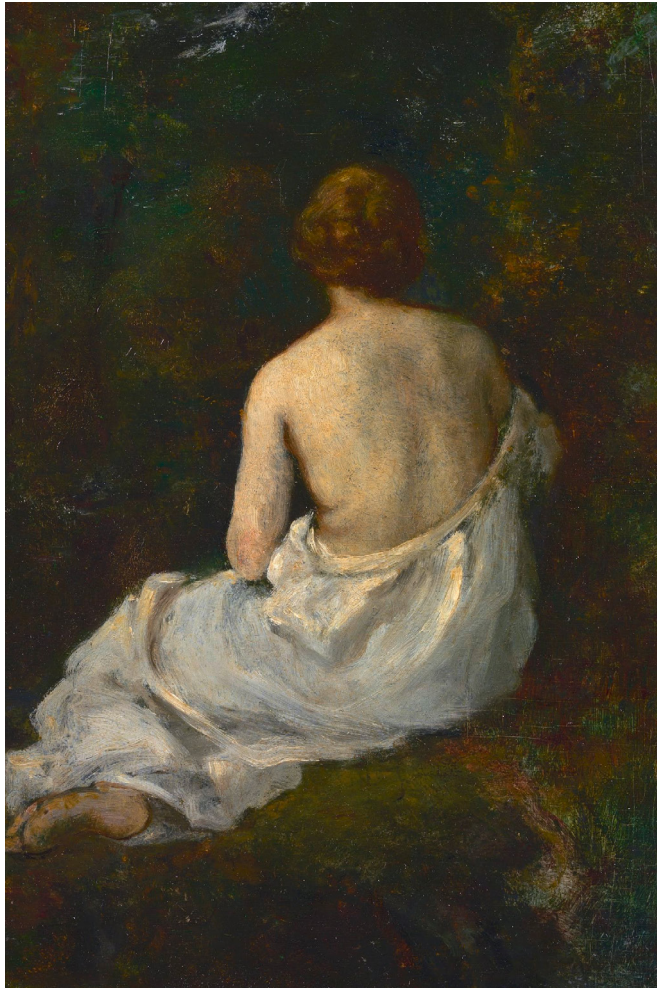

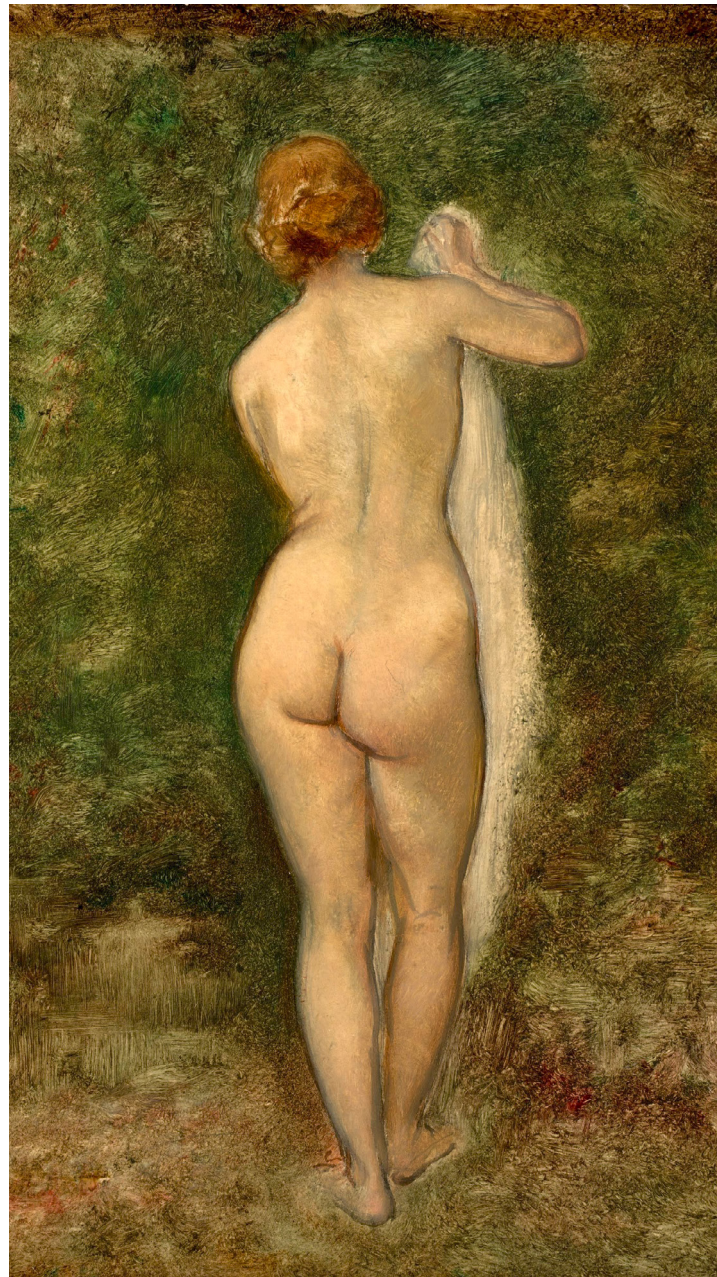

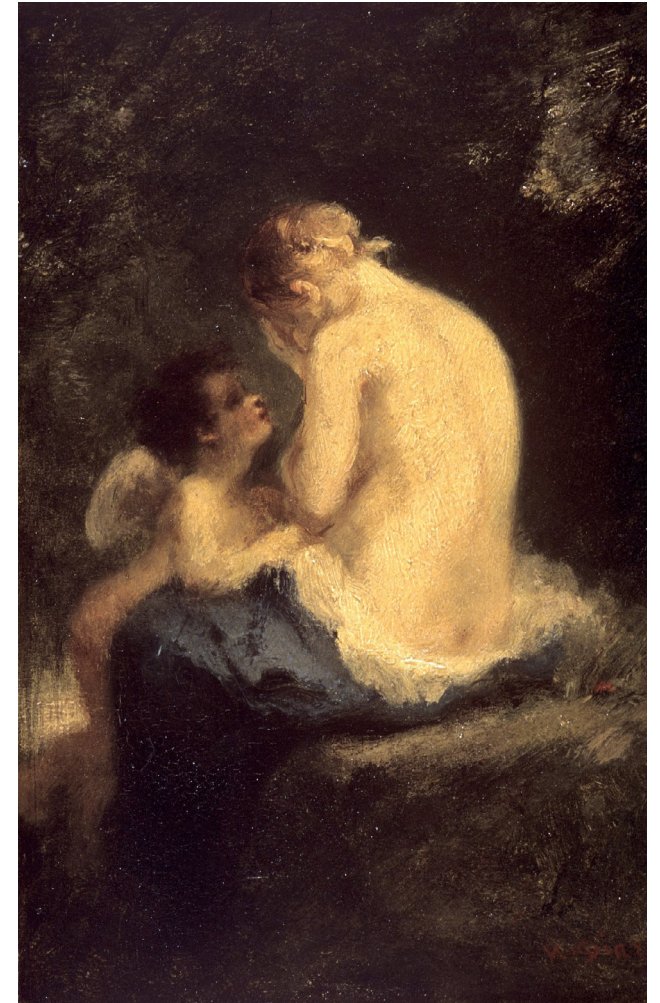




**Young Woman with Blond Hair** (1850s)

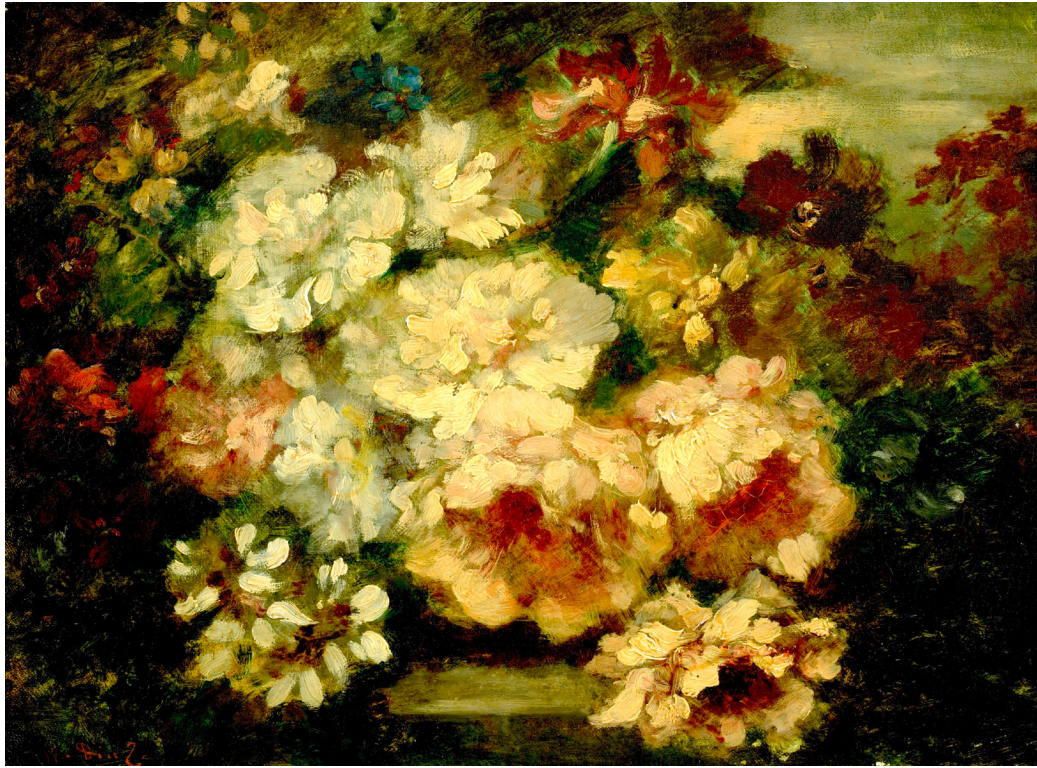


**Woman at her Bath** (1850s) The Mesdag Collection

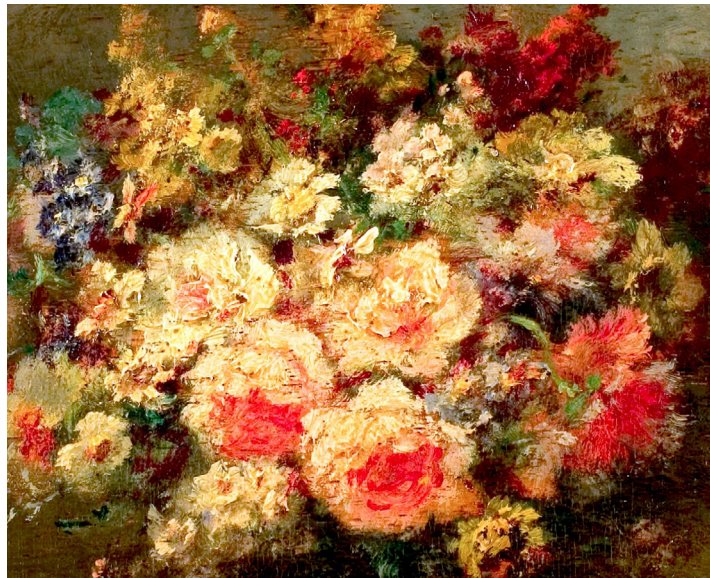


**Consolation of Love** (c1870)

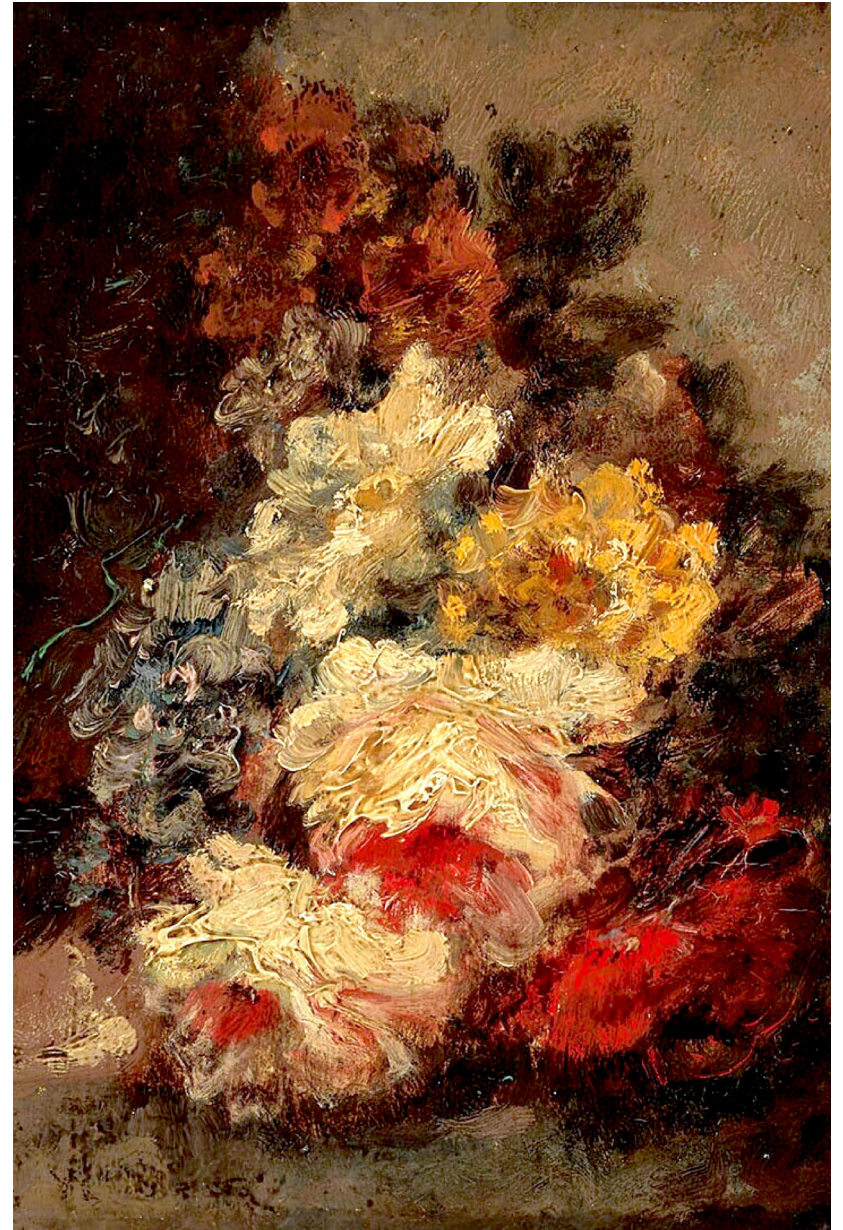




**Peonies** (c1850s)

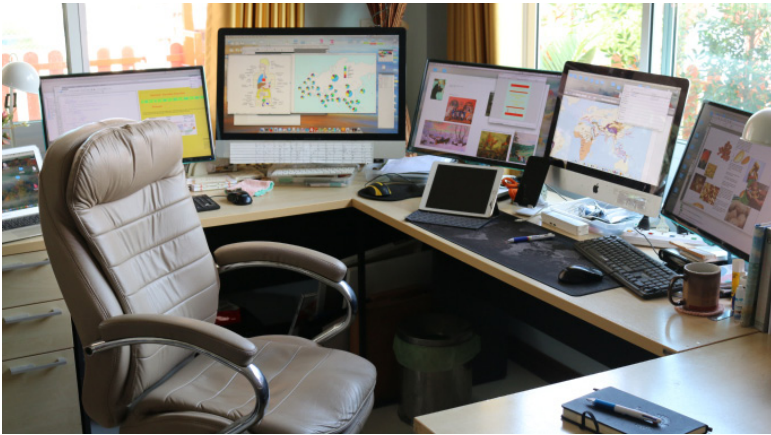
