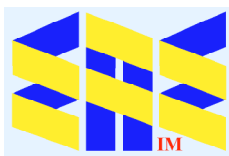

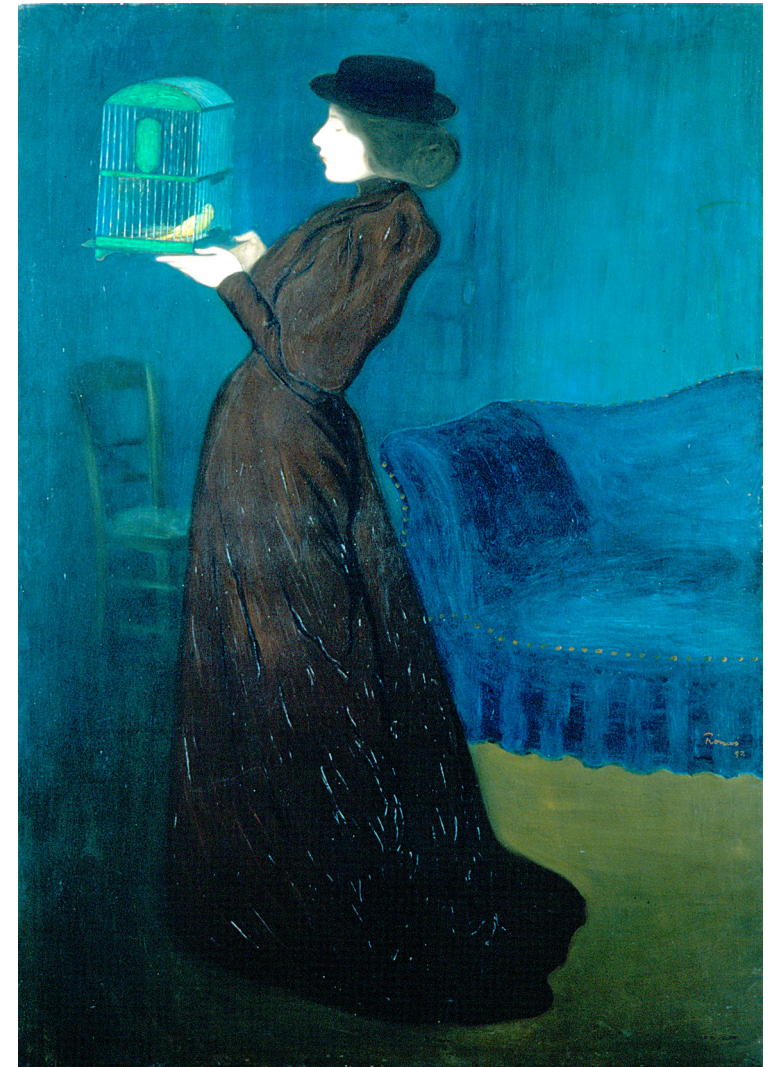
Self-Portrait in a Brown Hat (1897)

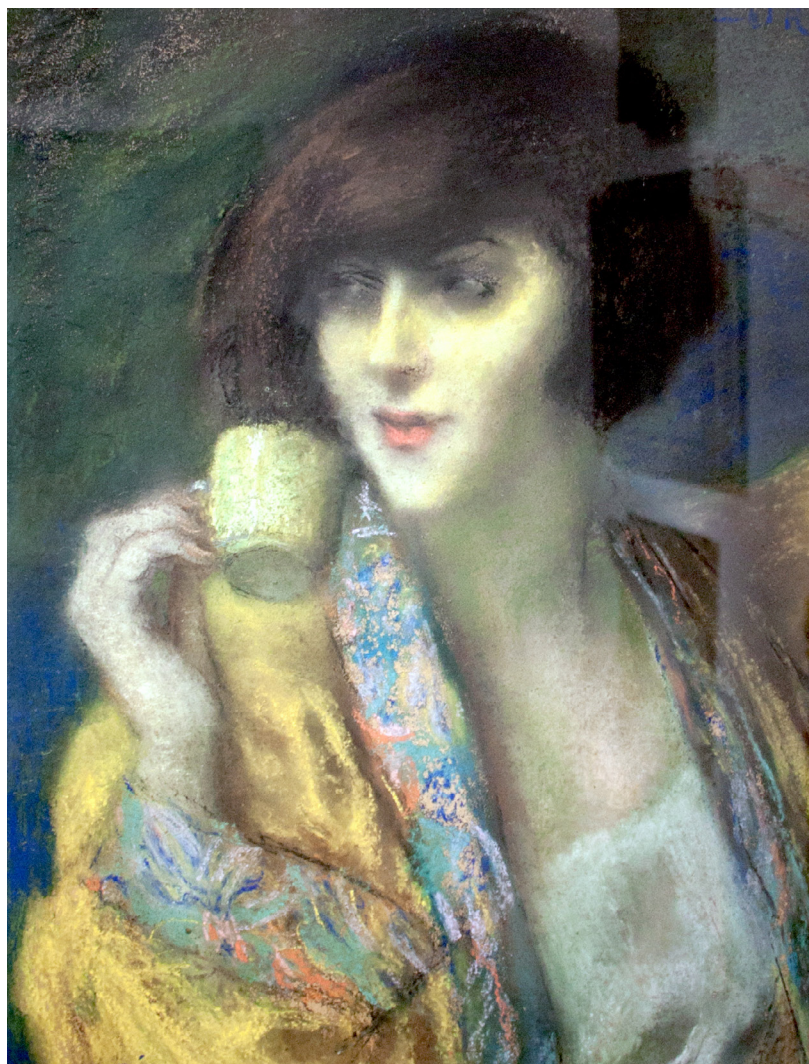


Woman with a Birdcage (1897)

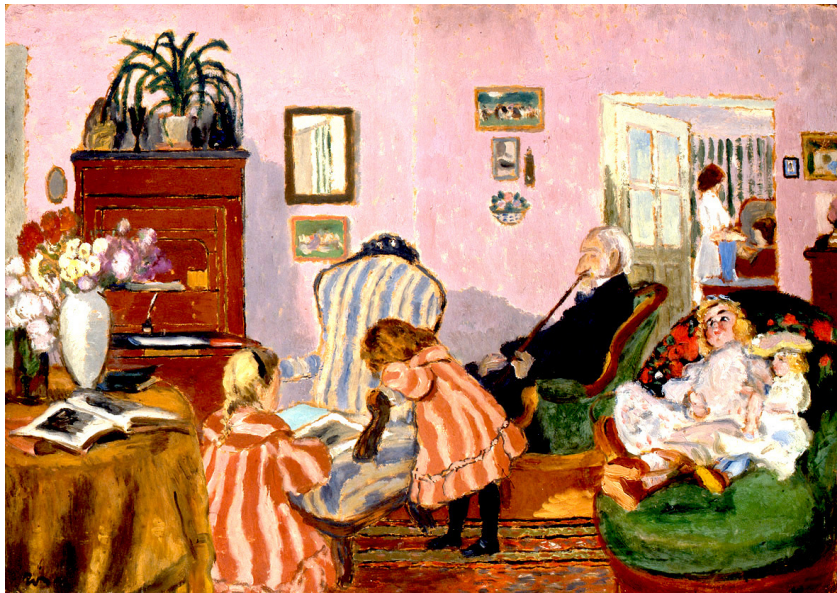

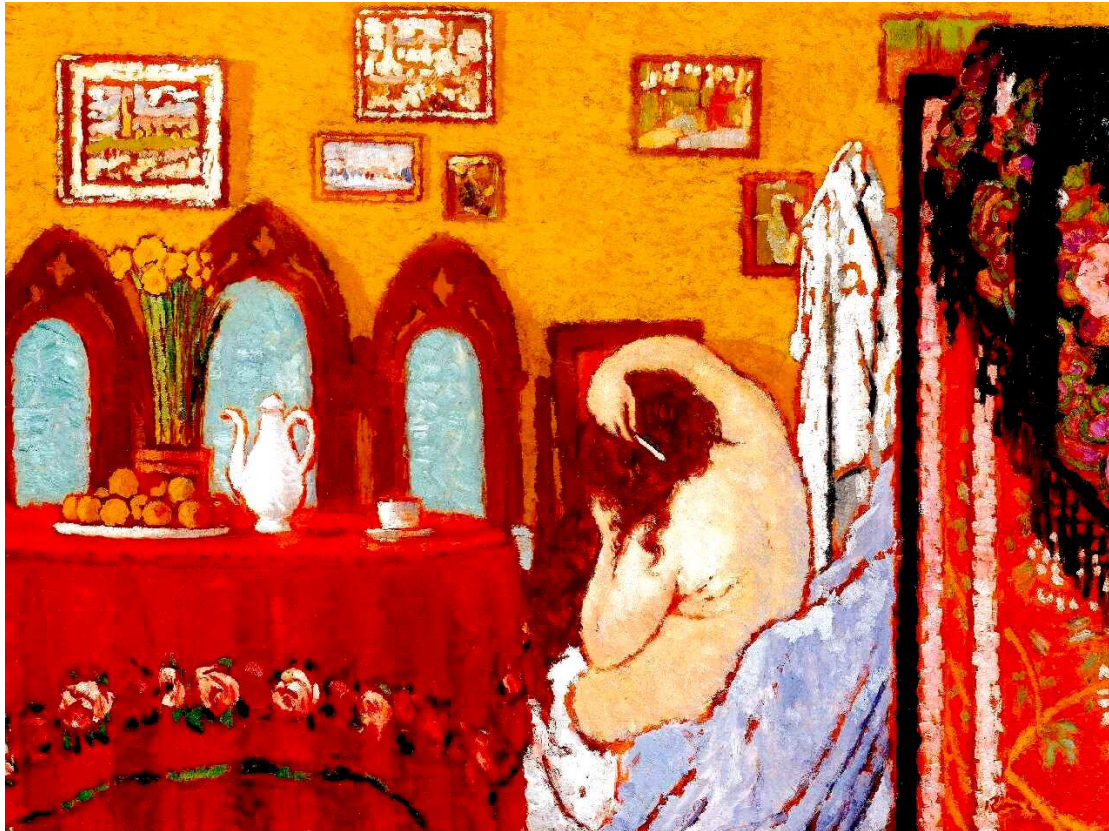
